

The two sites were chosen based on formal requests for the two systems. The City Administrator for the City of Tacloban requested one system for Suhi Health Center. The second SunSpring will be installed at Remedios Trinidad Romualdez Hospital per the request of Dr. Vincente Zeta. The proceeds of the recent H2OpenDoors Cwench party are responsible for part of the funding.
