



We would like to inform you that for the Rotary Year 2013-14 we had planned to give thrust for the rural community especially on literacy front. With this in view, we have distributed Dictionaries to 1000 students studying in 10th standard to improve their English knowledge. Secondly, the villages are having power for only a couple of hours in the night. In order to help the students study during the evening hours, we have provided Solar Lamps for 700 students studying in 10th standard in very remote villages. This project is called Vidyadeepa. We have installed the solar panels in Schools. Students are given the batteries. Students can charge the batteries once in two days in the school. After the examinations, students will return the lamp and battery to the school so that the students of next batch can make use of the lamps. This is really helping the students well.

While implementing these projects, we could notice that the schools are having very poor comfort station facilities. On account of this absenteeism and dropout rates are very high, especially girl students. Considering the student strength and facilities available, we have identified 6 schools for construction of comfort stations.

In order to implement this project, we would like to apply for a Global Grant and thought of approaching you to be our Partner Club. The estimated Project Cost will be USD 60000 (Eq to Indian Rs 38 lakhs). We have mobilized USD 10000 from our contacts in the US/Germany and will get these funds transferred to you. We shall be grateful if you can contribute USD 10000/- so that we can have a matching grant of USD 20000 from Rotary International and our club will contribute USD 20000 thus making a total of USD 60000/

We, therefore, request you to kindly look into this and participate in this Project.

If, for any reason, you are not in a position to come up with your contribution at this point of time, we will reduce the project to USD 30000 and get our friends to send USD 10000 to you which in turn you can contribute and be our Partner Club.

I shall be grateful if you could kindly give your positive response in the next few days to enable us to proceed for applying to RI. On hearing from you we can proceed further in the matter.

Incidentally, I will be visiting my daughter in Sunnyvale on the 21<sup>st</sup> April and will be spending couple of weeks. It will be a great pleasure if we can meet. Because of this trip, I am planning to complete the paperwork required for Global Grant before my departure. Hence, request for early action.


